Minimum age requirement 18 at time of booking.

The WSET® Educators Programme is intended to provide training in teaching skills and delivery of WSET courses for those planning on delivering WSET courses through the WSETs Approved Programme Provider network. It is the benchmark standard for those teaching on WSET courses.

Places on this course are restricted to 12 people.

Holding the WSET® Diploma or an internationally recognized equivalent plus the WSET® Advanced Certificate is a prerequisite for attendance on this course. The Educator Programme covers presentation and teaching techniques, the WSET® ethos, use of the Systematic Approach to Tasting and specific delivery of each level of course.

If you hold a teaching qualification you may be exempt from the presentation skills module.

Assessment is a 10 minute tasting at Advanced level and a 15 minute theory presentation at Intermediate level, observed by qualified and experienced Educators.

The WSET® recommends that students on this course complete at least 20 hours preparation before the start of the course. It is strongly recommended that anyone wishing to attend book in sufficient time to receive the study materials as you will need to familiarize with these to plan and prepare appropriate support materials for your assessment presentation.
