

London Wine & Spirit School - Great Grapes of the World Online Distance Learning Course Synopsis

Entry requirements	It will be assumed that students have basic computer literacy and internet navigation skills.
Study Programme	The course is split into 5 modules of study, to be taken at student's own pace, as described below.
Method of Study	This course is taught through a series of online multimedia activities.
What is Wine?	Learn about the components that make wines taste different.
Wine Tasting	Learn how to taste wines like the professionals and fully appreciate the diverse characteristics to be found in wine.
Food and Wine	A guide to making the most of your wine and dining experience.
Black Grapes	Study the major Black Grape varieties and learn about the wines produced from them: Cabernet Sauvignon & Merlot, Shiraz, Pinot Noir, Grenache, Tempranillo, Sangiovese, Gamay, Nebbiolo.
White Grapes	Study the major White Grape varieties and learn about the wines produced from them: Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Riesling, Viognier, Gewurztraminer, Pinot Grigio, Chenin Blanc, Semillon.
Study Materials	Students will receive access to online materials for the duration of the course.
Duration of Course	Up to 4 months (Study at own pace).
System Requirements	As this course is taught online, students will require access to a computer with the following minimum requirements: Internet Explorer 7, Firefox 3 or equivalent with Javascript support and pop-ups enabled Adobe Acrobat 7 or equivalent Adobe Flash 9 Internet access (broadband recommended)
